Richard Cary and Mary Lou Byrnes will be married August 31, 1946 At the home of Miss. Byrnes in Niles, Richigan.



Nan Reed will return to the University of Nichigan this fall.


Charlie Rensenhouse is enrolled at the University of Southern California, after his discharge from the Army Air Corps.
