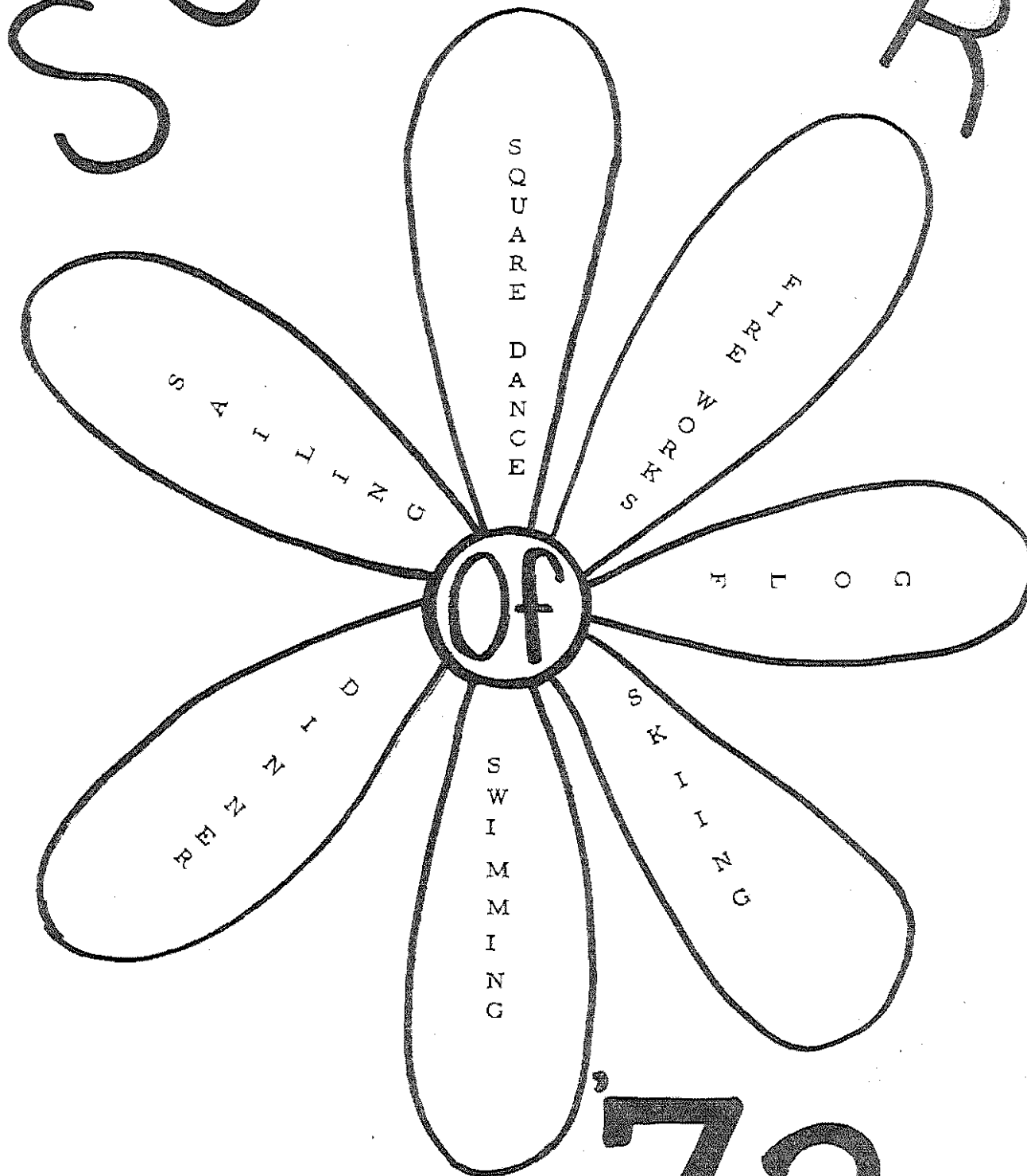

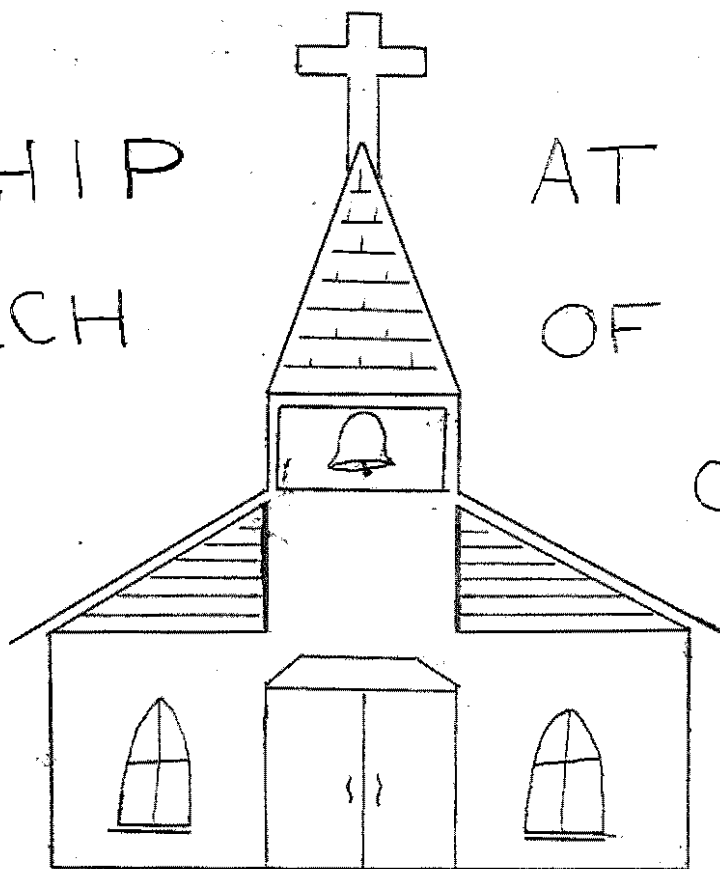
1. Regatta Races will not be counted in season standings. Regattas will be scored on Olympic system.
