Test Your Drinking Water

How's your drinking water? If it tastes good, you still don't know if the quality is good unless you make yearly checks by having a water sample analyzed. You can do this without cost by picking up a sample bottle at the Cass Co Dept. of Health in Cassopolis and mailing this bottle with a water sample to the testing lab. The results of the test will be given to the Board of Health who in turn will notify you of the results. It's a good idea to make sure your drinking water is pure.
