
#### From the Commodore:



FIRST AID TIP OF THE WEEK

Burns are rated as follows: Skin is:

- 1. Red 1st Degree
- 2. Blistered 2nd Degree
- 3. Charred 3rd Degree

Pain of first-degree and of a small second-degree burn can be relieved by excluding air. Three ways to exclude air from burn are:

- 1. Submerge in cold water for an hour or two.
- 2. Apply a cold pack.
- Cover with a thick dressing or unused plastic.
   DO NOT use plastic to keep air off a burn on the face.
