From the Commodore:

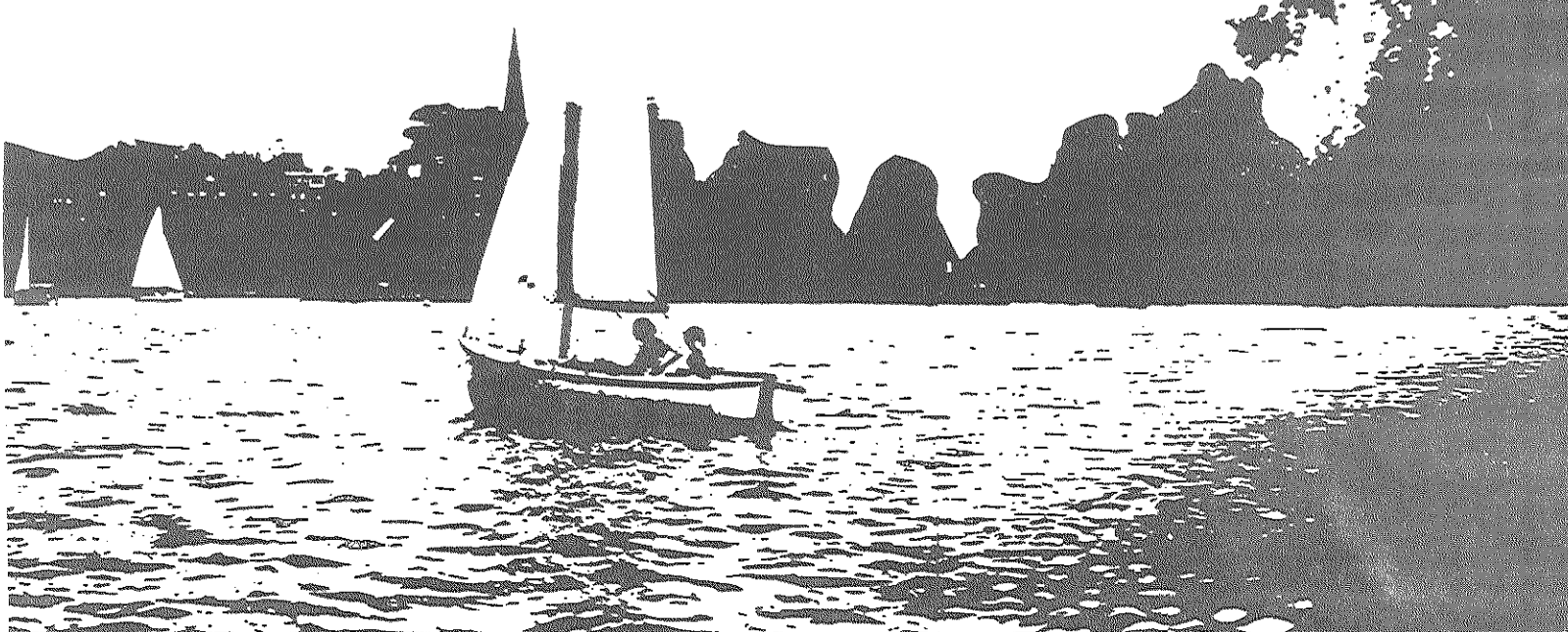

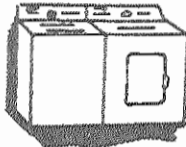
