Some of the items this week: TANKER BAN HB 5347 setting a statewide ban on double-bottom tankers by 1981 and requiring safety modification in the meantime has been approved by the Michigan House of Representatives.

HOME HEATING - HB 6313 extending deadline for fileing for home heating assistance to August 31 has been signed by Gov. Milliken. It also allows femilies with more than \$15,000 in liquid assets to qualify.

MINIMUM WAGE - The Attorney Gen'l. has ruled that employees who get tips are entitled to receive either the state or federal minimum wage, whichever is higher. Right now, both the state and federal levers are \$2.65 an hour, although they have varied at times in the past year.
