BOATING NEGLIGENCE

Incidents of boats, particularly PONTOON BOATS, going between a raft and pier have been coming to the attention of the Barker editor. This is very dangerous because swimmers are very likely to be in that area, as that is where they are supposed to play safely.

The above is one of the SAFETY RULES OF BOATING.

ANOTHER IS THAT YOU MUST STAY 100 FEET FROM ANY RAFT, PIER OR FISHING BOAT. BOATS MUST GO AROUND OUR LAKE COUNTER CLOCKWISE. THIS ENABLES YOU TO GET INTO THE FLOW

OF TRAFFIC WITHOUT CONFUSION.

Speed and racing and just fooling around are frowned on and we have always prided ourselves on the great cooperation of our lake people. Residents have always been courteous and helpful when skiing. If the area for take off and return is limited, most neighbors clear their area to faciliate the skier. Drivers of ski boats should be especially careful in staying far enough away from rafts, floats and fishing boats so that the skier on the end of the 75 ft. tow line can clear these objects in safety. WE HAVEN'T HAD ANY ACCIDENTS AND WE DON'T WANT ANY. REMEMBER, COURTESY AND COMMON SENSE ARE THE KEY REQUIREMENTS.

NOTE TO PROPERTY OWNERS WHO HAVE RENTALS

A list of boat rules should be posted in the RENTAL COTTAGE. Remember that the rule of counter clockwise travel is our own rule and should be known to newcomers. Once used, it is appreciated and the newcomer wonders why it is not used on all lakes.

EDITORS NOTE

We want our lake to be safe for all people and their pets. Common sense and decency, and the respect of your neighbors should be ALL we need to do this. If we all do the above and then drive our cars with the same courtesy we should be in great shape. Unnecessary driving back and forth on the lake roads creates DUST problems for many, unsafe conditions for walkers and bikers. Carelessness in turning into private driveways causes destruction at times (I witnessed the boundary stones being knocked out the other day - and the driver went merrily on his way even though he knew it) and unnecessary speed took the life of a cat and left some very sad youngsters the other day. UNFORTUNATELY, these complaints are not always done by our residents BUT if they are friends of lake people, then it is up to us to see that they know and respect the rules we set up for us to live by. After we have done all this, then we must turn to the law enforcement department of our community and I hope we will not find it necessary to do that. LET'S ALL HELP AND KEEP OUR LAKE A BEAUTIFUL AND SAFE PLACE WE ALL LOVE.

ARTICLE FROM THE RIPARIAN -- SWIMMERS ITCHING FOR RESHEARCH

Swimmer's itch plagues tens of thousands of people each year, but it may soon be under control. The National Science Foundation has given Hope College a \$15,334 grant for swimmer's itch research this summer. Harvey Blankespoor, a biology professor at Hope, will lead the 14 person froup studying the disease.

Only about one percent of Michigan's lakes are periodically plagued by swimmer's itch. Usually, it arrives for about a week in the early summer and again later in the season. Sometimes it vanishes for years before surfacing again, or it can become a regular part of the lake's yearly routine. The research group hopes to learn about the types of snails that promote the disease process, foods required in the affects growth.
