

Two new articles will appear in the Barker this summer. Herbally Yours and Kids Korner. Please take time to read them and comment. Hope everyone has a happy healthy summer.



### ICE CREAM SOCIAL





# How Many Squares Can You Find?


Counting squares in a 4x4 grid.

### Rake Your Shoreline

Even though the leaves have just appeared, we should turn our thoughts to the fact that many of last falls leaves are in the water. By raking those leaves out of the water you will help to reduce the nutrient pollution of the lake.

These leaves accumulate on the bottom of the lake and decompose. As they decompose they 1) use up oxygen in the bottom of the lake that the fish need to breath and 2) release nutrients (phosphorus, nitrogen etc.) that will grow weeds and algae.

Rake the leaves away from the shoreline and dispose of them properly. If leaves are burned, make sure the ashes , which are nutrients, will not reach the lake.

### Herbally Yours

The use of herbs and spices can create a whole new world of adventure. By using new herbs we can change common foods into gourmet dishes and cut way down on the amount of salt that is normally used. Do not overlook the fact that herbs are also terrific in making teas, natural dyes, craft items, cosmetics, medicinal uses and last but not least beautifully scented gardens. Each week we will explore one specific aspect of herb uses and will have a featured herb. This weeks herb will be MINT.

MINT - since mints grow wild on the shcreline of Birch Lake I felt it was a great idea to start with ways it can be used as it is available to all of us.

There are over 160 varietys of mint. Most mints are rampant perennial spreaders. Use mint for the following: A garnish in lemonaide, oil and vinegar dressing, add to green peas, use in fresh fruit compotes, make mint jellys, dry for making potpourris and sachets, good to freshen your breath, mix with cream cheese and serve with crackers, make hot or iced mint tea - it's delicious. For MEDICINAL uses- mint teas are used by many for headaches, stomach disorder(nausea & stomach gases) and has a soothing affect on ones nerves.

There are many more ways to use mint but this should help to start you on your way. Enjoy!




