

Herbally Icurs

Cooking with herbs is a whole
new world of adventure. By
using different herbs in cooking
we can wary the taste of many
foods that are sometime very
plain. Experiment with herbs
& spices by beginning with small
amounts & increase as necessary.
Seasoning is a personal preference
and also what appeals to the
taste buds. Remember, that
herbs and spices should be used
to enhance not overwhelm.

Fresh herbs can be gathered from the garden and then washed in cold water and then stored in plastic bags in the refigerator for several days. Large amounts can be chopped and frozen or dried in the oven.

Conversion Rule: 2t. of fresh herb = 3/4-lt. Loose crumbled herb = 1/4t. dried powdered

Try these different ways to use herbs this week on your family.

- Make seasoned flours to use for gravys, biscuits & to dust foods before frying. Mix 1-2t. of mixed herbs (such as sage, parsley, rosemary, marjorum, tyme, oregano & garlic) to 2c. flour.

- Herb Butters are a very good way to try new herbs that you are not familiar with. Use these butters on rolls, hot vegetables, broiled fish, eggs, potatoes & pasta.

CHIVE BUTTER

1/2 c. butter Blend all
1 T. chopped parsley & let
1 T. " chives stand l hr.
for flavors

DILL & OREGANO BUTTER to mellow!

lt. dried dillweed lt. dried oregano

SAGE & BACON BUTTER

1/2 c. butter 1/2 t. sage

4-5 strips crumbled bacon
