Herbally Yours

SAGE! A herb that can easily be grown in the garden deserves mention. It is a hardy perennial that withstands harsh winters. The leaves are coated with tiny silver hairs and has purplish flowers that appear in August. Use as a compainion plant with rosemary, cabbage and carrots to deter cabbage moths, beetles & carrot flies. Do NOT plant near cuanabers.

Use sage in teas, sausage, a must in stuffing, pork dishes and soft cheeses. Also try it in fresh vegetables. Remember a little goes a long way!


