

Registration fees are \$8.00. Lunches will be served at the Yacht Club for a minimal charge. We hope that all the Sunfish on the lake will register to vie for the 10 trophies plus a best junior under 16 trophy. Top sailors from many other lakes are expected to join us so it is a good opportunity to sail with people who are not from Birch Lake. Support your Yacht Club and your Sunfish Fleet by either sailing or watching the races.
