Earl Troeger is about to retire as Commodore. This will be, as near as I can tell, his 7th year as Commodore of the Birch Lake Yacht Club. The Troeger Family started coming to Birch Lake in 1944 and built on the south side in 1946. Earl and his brothers, Jack and Tom, were instrumental in starting the Yacht Club and the 1st races were held in 1948. The Snipe Class came forth and Earl and his sons, Jeff, Tom, and David sailed Snipes in Regattas all around the country until 1980. In 1965 they won the National and International High Point Championship in the Snipe Class.




