CHANGES - Due to a conflict with an M.C. regatta at Corey Lake, we are going to reschedule our July 4th Regatta from July 7th and 8th to June 30th and July 1st (today and tomorrow). We will sail two races today beginning at 2:00 P.M. and three races Sunday beginning at 10:30 A.M. Sorry about the short notice.

Also, we have had several requests to delay our starting time to allow time to travel from church and get boats rigged. We have had a scheduled 10:00 A.M. starting time for a number of years, however, we have usually had a late start in the neighborhood of 10:30 A.M. Accordingly, we will begin starting our regular Sunday races at 10:30 A.M. as of tomorrow, July 1. Times mentioned are, of course, Indiana time.

We will again be using the "2/3" rule this year. This means you must complete at least 2/3 of the races we sail in order to be eligible for trophies. For example, if we sail 24 races this season, you will have to finish at least 16 of these races.




