

Did you know that your Fire Dept is Newberg/Porter - located at Jones, Mi.? Porter Twp. Board has submitted the following proposition to be voted on at the general primary election on Tues. Aug. 5, 1986.

1. Fire Protection millage at a cost of $\frac{1}{2}$ mil (.50 per\$1000 of equalized valuation)

for 2 years for purpose of acquiring property and constructing a new fire station. 2. Fire protection tax levy at a cost of $\frac{1}{2}$ mil (.50 per \$1000 of equalized valuation) for the years 1986-87 for the purpose of acquiring property and erecting a building to house the Newberg-Porter Fire Protection Service.
