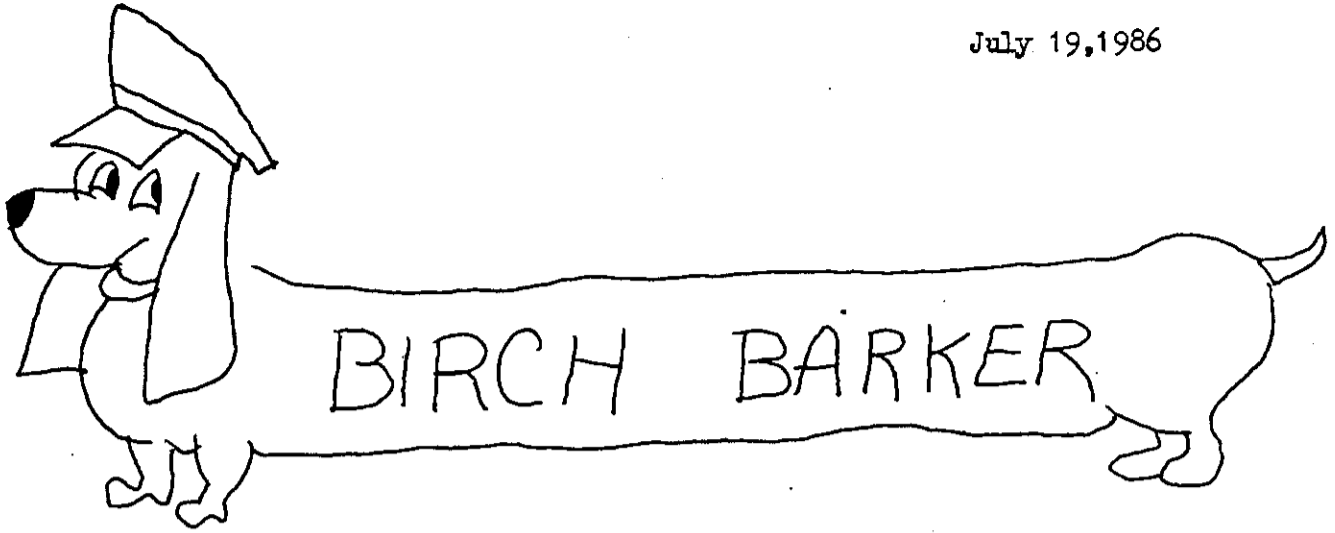


July 19, 1986

VOTERS OF PORTER TWP

Did you know that your Fire Dept is Newberg/Porter - located at Jones, Mi.? Porter Twp. Board has submitted the following proposition to be voted on at the general primary election on Tues. Aug. 5, 1986.

1. Fire Protection millage at a cost of $\frac{1}{2}$ mil (.50 per \$1000 of equalized valuation) for 2 years for purpose of acquiring property and constructing a new fire station.
2. Fire protection tax levy at a cost of $\frac{1}{2}$ mil (.50 per \$1000 of equalized valuation) for the years 1986-87 for the purpose of acquiring property and erecting a building to house the Newberg-Porter Fire Protection Service.

This Fire Station, which covers all of the North Half of Porter Twp (from Teasdale Lake Road North.) does a great job for all of Birch Lake in Fire protection and ambulance service. (They have a new ambulance ordered) They need your vote on Aug. 5 so please get out to vote in favor of a new fire station.
