Recipe Idea from B & J's Double Berry No-Bake Pie 1 Keebler Graham Cracker Ready-Crust Pie Crust

> 3/4 cup sugar 3 Tosp. cornstarch

1 Tosp butter

4 cups Blueberries

tsp. salt

1 Tosp lemon juice whipped cream (optional) 🕯 cup water

Combine sugar, cornstarch, and salt in saucepan. Add water and 2 cups blueberries. Cook over medium heat, stirring constantly, until mixture comes to a boil and is thickened. Mixture should be clear and very thick. Remove from heat and stir in butter and lemon juice. Cool. Place-remaining 2 cups raw blueberries in pie shell. Top with cooked blueberry mixture. Chill. Serve, garnished with whipped cream if desired.
