I am publishing the 1986 Budget for the Yacht Club so everyone can see where the membership dues go. The dues cover the Birch Barker, Riparian Magazine and expenses of the Yacht Club Building. All the social functions and sailing events collect from the participants and try to break even. To date 140 of the 200 residents have joined the Yacht Club.

With the taxes, utilities and insurance increasing, we feel it necessary to increase the dues. The Board voted to increase the 1987-88 dues to \$20.00 per family.

WATER QUALITY

As residents of beautiful Birch Lake, we are all concerned about the water quality.

The Board would like to update you on the progress of our water quality committee.

The water quality committee has reported that 100% of Birch Lake property owners gave the Cass County Health Department permission to inspect the sewage disposal sytem servicing their dwellings.

A house-to-house on-site evaluation was completed last fall. As a result of these inspections, some were identified as potential contamination threats to the lake. May 22, 1986, 63 letters were mailed by the Health Department to ask for cooperation to do more extensive evaluation. Most have responded. For those not responding a second letter was mailed on July 2, 1986.

Approximately 25 systems have been installed or plan to be installed this year. urge you all to cooperate with the Health Department. These corrections will work toward

improving Birch Lake water quality.

GRILLED SCALLOPPED POTATOES & HAM 8 servings

6 med potatoes, peeled & sliced thin

‡ cup chopped onion or minced dry onion

1 cup diced ham

1 can (10 3/4 oz) cream of mushroom soup, undiluted

½ cup milk

1 tsp salt

1/8 tsp pepper

Grease an 11 x 7" aluminum foil pan & set aside. In a large bowl combine sliced potatoes, onions & ham, & mix lightly. In a small bowl combine soup, milk, salt, pepper, & blend very well. Blend that into potatoe mixture & pour in a greased pan. Grill it uncovered over medium hot coals for about 1 hour.
