I've been seeing quite a few fishermen on weekends but the good sized ones just aren't off my pier like they used to be. JOYCE KLIMEK writes "When a large number of good sized dead fish were found on Lazy Lodge shores, I called the DNR. We were the seventeenth lake to report in. They said it was due to lake stratification at this time of year. You remember — cold water on the bottom comes up because surface waters are warming up, so in simple terms, it rolls over. Due to lack of oxygen while this was happening, many fish died.

The DNR was also asked to look into our depleating minnow population which is probably due to the large amount of trapping that is taking place. It took many phone calls, but on JUNE 1, Denny Gordon and helper came to Birch to check the minnows. Actual observation around the lake and verification by several residents were cause for Denny to make a report to Dave Johnson which could lead to the banning of minnow trappers from Birch Lake for as long as 5 years. YIPPEE!!
