## WATER QUALITY UPDATE

July 19, 1987

Dear Birch Lake Residents:

As you know, a long term lake management program designed by the Health Department is in effect: 9 year-round monitors are positioned around the lake and at the stream to sample water for nutrient and coliform contamination on a regular basis. Monitors providing this service for you: Sherry Holleman Station #1 Cove. Gertie Temple Station #2 North Shore. Terry Curtis Station #3 N.E. Bay. Jim Mitchell Station #4 residential stream inlet to Bay. Tom Nagy Station #5 East Shore. Angie Lovejcy Station #6 S.E. Shore. Dan Reynolds Station #7 South Shore. Julie Jankowski Station #8 West Shore. Nancy Walker Station #9 West Shore. Nutrient testing will begin in August. Coliform testing is weekly. Below is an update from the 5 page report provided you by the Health Department and the Birch Lake Yacht Club Water Quality Committee. You may recall from the report that monitors picked up high coliform bacteria on all shores and in the stream.

On June 5, June 9 and June 28, Station #4 recorded the stream: Suspicious

As you can see, faulty systems are still contributing to high coliform recorded by our testing stations - evidence of residential sewage pollution and unsafe water.

This is where you all can help. If there is any possibility of your having a faulty system, "Please" call the Water Quality Committee immediately and assist us in helping to clean up this public problem.

RUN: 3 MILES - Down the hill, right on Lakeshore to Kiloqua Woods, back Lakeshore past Yacht Club to turnaround, finish at Yacht Club Entrance.

There will be a meeting FRIDAY AUGUST 7TH at the Yacht Club to review the rules, explain the course, and answer questions. The meeting will be at 6:00PM Indy time and should last no longer than 30 minutes.
