The ANNUAL MEETING of the BIRCH LAKE IMPROVEMENT ASSOCIATION was held last Saturday in the Yacht Club due to a rain storm, 13 members were present including 5 officers and directors. Business included the possibility of sending a representative to the MICHIGAN LAKES & STREAMS ANNUAL MEETING in Sept., permits in-hand for 3 new sea walls (which must follow the shoreline), possible closing of Birch Lake to minnow trappers, and election of new officers and directors. There was much discussion of local politics, taxes, busing, etc. New officers serving a 2 year term are JOYCE KLIMEK - PRES, LE KING - SEC, DON ERHARDT - DIR, DOUG WEAVER - DIR. The meeting was adjourned after a discussion on WATER QUALITY which seems to be the topic most discussed on the lake today.

WATER TEMP

On Monday, August 3, the Dept. of Fisheries took its first study of Birch Lake since 1937 according to JACK ASIRE, who just happened to stop them as they were wading along the shoreline checking ph and water temperatures. They stated that the average water temp was 83 and quite high this year, the ideal depth for bluegills at this time would be 21 feet according to the officers. We've been taking our own temp readings since March off CRANMERS pier at about 5 feet and are showing a temp of almost 90 degrees.

CLAUDIA PRESENTS


