GEMS FROM BIRCH LAKE By: Arline Machalleck

Birch Lake is unique in its population! The early residents were awed by its clear waters, good fishing and beauty. The indians called it "Medicine Lake" because of the healing powers due to the marl bottom.

Others came to the public beaches to picnic and swim and captivated by the beauty and quiet, found a place to rent and then eventually buy or build their own place.

Among these were LESLIE and MARGARET JENSEN who, in the early 1920's, came for cook-outs at the Cove Beach, then rented the Eubank cottage on the South side (now the Welsh's home) before building their present home on the South side of the lake in August 1946.

Because it was almost impossible to get material after the war, they bought a used prefabricated building and got the well pipes from a burned-out home. Thus the beginning of Cottage #42, later 14918 Birch Lakeshore Drive.

The Jensen's came here from South Bend where Les was a wood pattern maker in the jobbing industry.

They have one daughter, Kay, who has spent her summers at the cottage every year but one; that summer she was pregnant and was not allowed to fly from their home in California. Married to Bob Greenig and living in Upland, California their daughter. Lesley Ann, is following her Mother's pattern, having spent every one of her 13 birthdays at Birch Lake.

The Jensens, after some remodeling, made the cottage their permanent home in 1976. Summering at Birch Lake and wintering in Upland, California and married for 62 years, they love both places and feel they have the best of two worlds.

- A LITTLE HISTORICAL GEOGRAPHY Submitted by Dan Reynolds

Continued - One of the interesting features of the valley is the way it was created by the sudden lowering of old Lake Mogador several thousands of years ago. This change made possible the easy excavations of the vast amount of marl which has been taken out for fertilizer.

In 1929, while excavating for marl just north of Mogador Church (Log Chapel on Chapel Hill) the skeleton of an elephant, which preceded the mastodon here, was found under about 20 feet of earth. Scientists from the University of Michigan figured it had died between 50,000 AND 70,000 years ago. Also fossils of prehistoric plants have been found in the valley.

When the first settlers arrived they found Mogador Valley occupied by Pottawatomie Indians. The settlers found the valley a veritable patchwork of Indian trails, crossing Angle Creek, the Sauk Trail (now US12) going back and forth from Long and Baldwin Lakes to Shavehead and Birch Lakes and Williamsville and Union.




