TRIATHLON APPROACHES

AUGUST 6th is fast approaching and we are again anticipating a record number of participants for our fifth annual Birch Lake Triathlon. The course will remain the same as 1987, with the exception of 12 years of age and under individuals and relays. Our youngsters will have a shorter swim, bike, and run distance. Start time 8:30 AM (IND.)

In order to participate you must be a member of a family that lives on Birch Lake. This year there will be special trophies to the winners of certain relays: UNDER 12 RELAY, ALL FEMALE RELAY.

In addition, trophies will be awarded to the first three finishers in the men's and women's individual competition and the first three relays. All participants will receive a T-shirt and finisher trophy.

The entry fee is \$10 for individual and \$30 for a relay. Entry forms should be delivered to DAN REYNOLDS, or to a Yacht Club Director.

SWIM: 1/4 MILE- South Shore (Welches to Carpenters)

BIKE: 7 MILES - Lakeshore to Sears to Robbins Lake Road to Shavehead to Birch to Sears. ALL BIKERS ARE STRONGLY URGED TO WEAR HELMETS.

RUN: 3 MILES - Down the hill, right on Lakeshore to Kiloqua Woods, back Lakeshore past Yacht Club to turnaround, finish at Yacht Club Entrance.

There will be a meeting FRIDAY AUGUST 5th at the Yacht Club to review the rules, explain the course, and answer questions. The meeting will be at 6:00 PM Ind. time and should last no longer than 30 minutes.


