On the back of this week's Barker is a map of Birch Lake which shows the progress to date of our Water Quality Program. A larger map is on display at the Yacht Club. The graph in the center indicates by section of the lake those systems which have been replaced. The solid dots on the perimeter of the lake indicate those residences found to be in noncompliance by the Cass County Health Department which have not been replaced.

Eventhough we have made progress, you can see that we have a longway to go. Many systems are in the process of being corrected this fall. As a system is corrected, the solid dot on the perimeter is removed and a circle takes its place on the graph. We are certainly hopeful that most of all of the systems will be corrected before the season begins in 1989. Some residents have known of their faulty systems since 1985.

l can virtually guarantee that stronger action will be taken by the Health Department and County Prosecutor in early 1989. So let's get rid of those solid dots. 


