

RECIPES FOR THE WEEK

SPINACH CASSEROLE

4-6 servings

- 2 eggs, well beaten
- 1 1/2 cup cottage cheese
- 6 tablespoons all purpose flour
- 1 1/2 cup grated cheddar cheese
- 1 pkg(10 oz) frozen chopped spinach, thawed 1/2 teaspoon salt

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Beat eggs and flour in a bowl until smooth. Stir in spinach, cottage cheese, cheddar cheese and salt. Mix well. Pour into greased 1 qt. casserole. Bake for 1 hour.

BARBEQUED PORKLOIN ROAST 6-8 PEOPLE

1 3-4 lb. Porkloin roast - boneless Salt and pepper 1/4 cup sugar 1/3 catsup 3 tablespoons vinegar 1 tablespoon prepared mustard 1 tablespoon veg oil

Season roast with salt and pepper to taste. Wrap loosley with foil. Grill over med hot coals for 1 hour. While roasting combine remaining ingredients in a small pan. Bring to a boil — reduce heat and simmer 5 min. Stirring often. After 1 hour baste roast with sauce. Continue basting every 15 min. until done. About 2 hours.
