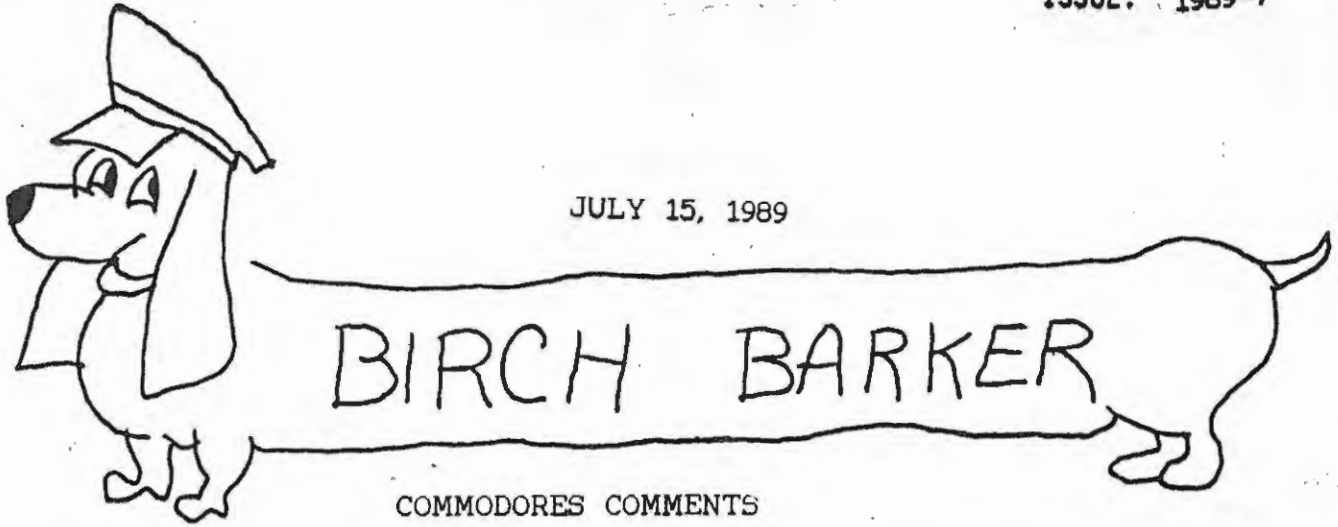

## RECIPES FOR THE WEEK

### NACHO DIP by Linda Bergan

- 1 8 oz softened cream cheese
- 1 can hormel chili without beans
- 1 package shredded cheddar cheese

Spread cream cheese in about a 9" pie pan. Top with chili then cheese. Put in microwave over till cheese melts. Serve with nacho chips. You can add any hot spices to this if you like !

### GARDEN CASSEROLE Donna Cranmer Serves 6-8 people

- 3 small carrots - peeled and sliced
- 1/2 lb. green beans - cleaned and broken in pieces
- 1 small yellow squash - sliced
- 1 small zucchini - sliced
- 1/4 cup butter - divided
- 1 clove garlic, minced (I used minced inst. onion)
- 1 cup chicken broth
- 1 tsp. salt
- 1/2 tsp white pepper (I used black)

Arrange vegetables in buttered casserole. In small pan melt 2 tablespoons butter. Add garlic or onion, cook and stir. Add chicken broth and salt and pepper. Pour mixture over vegetables. Dot with remaining butter, cover and bake at 350 degrees for 30 minutes until done. Can be done on the grill also.

### BROCCOLI SALAD serves 6 Sherry Holleman

- 1 Bunch Broccoli, cut up, peel stems, & slice & chop in small pieces
- 1/2 medium red onion thinly sliced
- 1/4 cup raisins
- 5 slices bacon - cooked crisp & crumbled

Dressing: 1/2 cup mayonaise  
1/4 cup sugar                      Mix well  
1 tablespoon

Mix all, except the bacon, refrigerate & add the bacon just before serving. Toss gently before serving.
