SCALLOPED POTATOES & HAM by Donna Cranmer 8 servings

6 med. potatoes, peeled & sliced 1/4 cup chopped onion or equivalent in instant minced onion. 1 cup diced ham 1 can cream of mushroom soup-undiluted 1/2 cup milk 1 teaspoon salt 1/8 teaspoon pepper

Grease an aluminum foil pan. In a bowl combine potatoes, onion, and ham, mix lightly. Combine soup, milk, salt, and pepper - blend well. Blend into potatoe mixture. Pour into prepared pan. Grill on your outdoor grill uncovered over medium coals about 1 hour or until potatoes are done. The lid on the grill should be closed . This can be done in the oven also.




