SAFETY COMMITTEE

With the increasing popularity of wave riders and jet skis on the lake, the committee thought it would be important to provide some of the basic Michigan laws governing the use of these water vehicles. Basically the laws are very similar to those of motorized watercraft. As in all water activities, common sense and courtesy are the key factors.

Laws and Rules For Wave Riders and Jet Skis:

1. Vehicles will be driven in a counter clockwise direction at all times, the same as all watercraft.

- 2. Vehicles will be driven 100 feet from piers, rafts, and other watercraft.
- Vehicles will be driven at no-wake speed within 100 3. feet of entering or leaving a docking area.
- Life jackets must be worn at all times while operating 4. the vehicle.
- At no time shall a vehicle tow a person on skis, boards 5. or tubes.
- 6. Any driver must be 16 years of age or possess a power boating permit.

All owners of jet skis and wave riders need to familiarize every person they authorize to use a vehicle of the rules and laws.

The committee would also like to ask as a courtesy, that wave riders and jet skis be limited to use during the hours of 9:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. (Indiana time).
