#### RECIPES OF THE WEEK

ORIENTAL SALAD Submitted by Pam Mullin and Associated

Oriental Salad (Cabbage Salad): 1) 1 small head cabbage, chopped Mix together 2) 1 bunch green onions, sliced thin 3) 3 tsp. Sesame seed
4) 1/3 cup slivered almonds
Brown in frying pan & add to cabbage Dressing: 1) 1 tablespoon sugar 1/3 - 1/2 cup oil 2) 3) 1 teaspoon salt 1 teaspoon MSG 4) 1/2 teaspoon pepper
3 tablespoons Rice Vinegar 5) 6) 7) Seasoning packet from Chicken flavor Ramon Noodles Mix and toss over salad. Do not cook. Chill 1 hour before Crush uncooked Ramon Noodles on top just before serving.

# CLAIRE'S CHERRY BARS Submitted by Claire

Mix well and pat into ungreased 13 by 9" pan: the set 2 cups all purpose flour 1/2 cup sugar

1 cup butter

serving.

Bake 12 to 15 minutes or until golden brown. (350 degrees F)

Meanwhile, in medium size mixing bowl, beat together 1/4 cup flour, 1/2 tsp. baking powder, 1/2 tsp. salt, 2 eggs, 1 egg yolk, 1 & 1/2 cups brown sugar. Beat until smooth. Stir in 1 cup halved and drained Marascino cherries (10 oz. jar) and 1 cup chopped nuts.

Pour over crust. Continue to bake 20 to 25 minutes until set and golden.

When cool, frost with the following glaze:

1 egg white 1 tablespoon melted butter 2 cups powdered sugar

2 tablespoons reserved cherry juice
