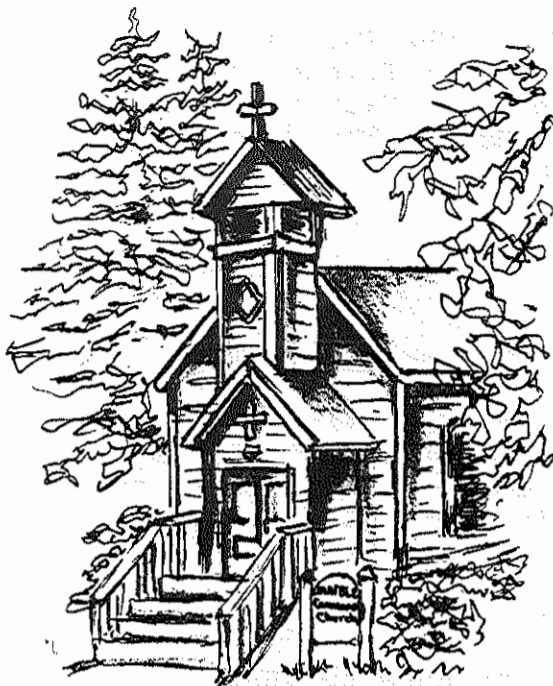
Two races will be held Sunday as scheduled if the weather permits.
