MRS. COMMODORE SUE'S HELPFUL HINTS

To peel an orange or grapefruit to use the sections in a salad, immerse the whole fruit in a pot of boiling-hot water and let stand 4 minutes. Remove fruit from the water and cool until it is easy to handle. When you peel away the skin, the pith should come with it. Any remnants can be removed with a grapefruit knife.

When cooking corn on the cob, adding salt to the boiling water will toughen the corn. Add it after cooking.

Spray a grater with non-stick vegetable spray before grating foods like cheese and citrus rind and cleanup will be a snap.

Confused by the term "dash"? A dash is about 1/16th of a teaspoon. Many measuring spoon sets have an 1/8th teaspoon measure, so fill it about half full.

If you love fruit juice but are counting calories, dilute it with sparkling water.



JET SKIS & WAVE RUNNERS 1997 - ANAL AND 1997

Remember that personal watercraft must follow the same rules as regular watercraft. The following laws must be adhered to:

- Always operate in a counter clockwise direction. 1.
- No wake within 100 feet of shore, piers, or rafts. 2. Leave the dock area at idle speed until watercraft is 100 feet from pier or raft.
- Must maintain 100 feet distance from all other 3. watercraft (including other wave runners) at wake speed.
- Must maintain 150 feet distance when following 4. another watercraft (including other wave runners) at wake speed.

COURTESY RULES

- 1) Do not operate jet skis or wave runners before 9:00a.m.
- after 7:00p.m. (Indiana)
 Do not hot dog on the lake other than in the middle of the lake.
