CPR SAVES LIVES!

BE PREPARED. LEARN CPR SKILLS.

CPR (Cardio pulmonary Resuscitation) properly performed and promptly - i.e. before "sudden death" has resulted in "biological death" -- can give victims the time to receive treatment by advanced medical techniques. About two-thirds of deaths occur before the victim reaches the hospital. When CPR is started within 4 minutes, the victim's chances of leaving the hospital alive are four times greater than if the victim did not receive CPR until after 4 minutes.

Instructors are certified by the American Red Cross. You will not only learn the necessary skills to perform CPR, but you will also learn how to recognize warning signs of heart attack and stroke and what to do in case they occur. Individual certification is for one year.

Objectives: Recognize the signals of heart attack and provide care to reduce the chance of cardiac arrest.
