# Three Suspects Captured In Cassopolis Robberies

CASSOPOLIS - A local man and two juveniles who police say admitted participating in two armed robberies Friday afternoon were arrested by police in a roadblock at M-62 and U.S. 12 at 2:40 p.m Friday.

Roosevelt Hart, 19, of 120 N. O'Keefe St. Cassopolis, and two juveniles are being held in Cass County Jail awaiting court disposi-tions. Bond was set at \$10,000 for Hart The first of the two robberies occurred at

the Hugh Henderson residence, 116 N O'Keefe St., reported to police at 1 p.m. Case Village Police Chief Frank Williams report ed that three black youths used a scall snub-nosed pistol to rob two disabled veterans, taking \$12 from one and \$2 from the other. Their names were not released. and both reside at the Henderson residence

A small portable radio also was taken Both victims were fied and gagged. One of the veterans was locked in the bathroom and the other in a bedroom closet, according to police.

At 2 p.m. Cass County Sheriff's deputie were called to Tom's Garage in Williams ville. Two males entered the station and told owner Tom Griffich "This is a stick up, we're not fooling. It's for real." Griffichwas tied, gagged, and locked in the

backroom, He told deputies that \$35 was taken from the cash register-and a small snub-nosed pistol was carried by one of the 111.11


Deputies sent out a broadcast to area police departments and a roadblock at M 62 and U.S. 12 was established.


