RECIPE OF THE WEEK

BEEF STROGANOFF

- 2 lb. top round (or sirloin), cut in strips
- 3 t shortening (or vegetable oil)
- 1 onion, chopped
- 1 can mushroom soup
- 1/2 cup water
- 1 cup sour cream
- 1 can mushrooms, drained

Brown meat and onion; season to taste. Add mushroom soup and water and cook until meat is tender (about 1 1/2 hours). Add sour cream and mushrooms. Do not boil. Serve over rice.
