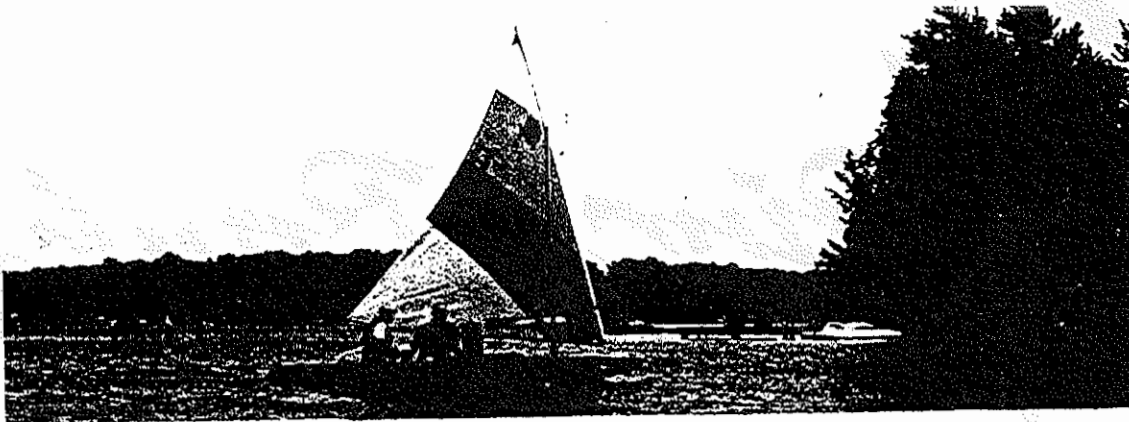
Independence Day and the Fourth of July have become nearly synonymous, but the Continental Congress actually voted for independence from Great Britain on July 2, 1776. The Declaration of Independence was signed two days later to explain the action already taken. John Adams wrote effusively to his wife Abigail that "The second day of July, 1776, will be . . . celebrated by succeeding generations as the great anniversary festival . . . solemnized with pomp and parade, with shows, games, sports, guns, bells, bonfires, and illuminations, from one end of this continent to the other, from this time forward, forevermore." Based on that equally confident and erroneous prediction, if John Adams were here today he would probably either be a meteorologist or an economist.

The following events are scheduled for the Fourth of July weekend. The fireworks display will be launched from Camp Tannadoonah and is planned for dark on Friday, July 4, with a "raindate" of Saturday July 5. The Boat Parade will be at 4 p.m. (Ind. time), 5 p.m. (Mich. time) on Saturday, July 5 and will begin and finish at John and Claudia Gableman's (S 48) with trophies to be distributed by a distinguished and incorruptible panel of judges. The Boat Parade is a perfect opportunity for exhibitionists and voyeurs alike, so plan either to participate in a boat or cheer from shore. The Pancake Breakfast will be on Sunday, July 6 at Camp Tannadoonah beginning at 8 a.m. (Ind. time), 9 a.m. (Mich. time). The Birch Lake Yacht Club makes a donation to Camp Tannadoonah out of the proceeds of the Pancake Breakfast.
