The Michigan Boating Safety Certification course will be presented by the Cass County Marine Sheriff's Department on August 9, 1997 at the BLYC clubhouse from 8 a.m. to 1 p.m. (Michigan time), 7 a.m. to 12 noon (Indiana time). At the conclusion of the course, boating safety certificates will be awarded to successful participants aged 12 to 16. These certificates entitle persons between the ages of 12 and 16 to operate watercraft with motors greater than 6 horsepower in Michigan, without the immediate supervision of an older person. The course is also recommended for persons over age 16 as a useful refresher on water safety principles and boating laws and regulations. Persons who are now age 11 may take the course this year, and will receive their boating safety certificates when they reach age 12. Those interested in this course should telephone the Cass County Sheriff's office at (616) 445-8644 to register (registration is necessary so the certificates can be prepared for distribution at the conclusion of the course). There is no charge for the course. Participants should bring a #2 pencil and a bag lunch.
