### LADIES LUNCHEON





#### HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION NEWS

The 1997 annual meeting of the Birch Lake Homeowners' Association took place on Saturday, August 16, 1997 at the Birch Lake Yacht Club clubhouse. An overview of the development and purposes of the Homeowners' Association was presented, emphasizing its nonpartisan informational role as to matters (such as school millage issues) on which Birch Lake homeowners may have differing views. Reports were given on the activities of the board, including attending Porter Township and Constantine School Board meetings, and information was provided about the 7.75 mill thirty-five year construction bond issue requested by Constantine Public Schools, the Porter Township/Newberg Township dispute over the provision of fire and ambulance service to Birch Lake, and various other matters. A vote on the Constantine Public Schools millage request is scheduled for September 23, so those entitled to vote should plan to do so to make sure their position on the matter is counted. A board of five directors was elected to serve for three year terms ending with the annual meeting in the Summer of 2000: Dean Davis, Bill King, Herm Kruggel, Rick Russwurm and Scott Troeger.

Enclosed with this issue of the Birch Barker is a form for providing precise directions to your home to the Cass County 911 information center. If you provide this information it will be entered into the 911 computer system and will appear automatically on the operator's screen when "911" is dialed. This is designed to improve response time in the event of an emergency. 
