Water Quality Update

You have probably noticed that the clarity of Birch Lake is outstanding. Tests this Spring with a Secchi disk revealed readings of 21 & 26 feet. The Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) considers 12-15 feet superior.

In addition, bacteria, fecal coliform, nitrogen & phosphorus profiles continue to be excellent. Birch is in the best shape ever since testing & water quality work began in the late '70s. Your Water Quality Committee is available to address any specific residential problems.

Birch Lake is also a member of the Michigan Lakes & Stream Association (MLSA), which gives us access to all it's programs & conferences. This year Birch became a member of the Cooperative Lakes Monitoring Program, a cooperative venture between the MLSA, the DEQ & the CLMP. Fewer than fifty lakes belong to this elite program.

The Water Quality Committee continues to monitor on a regular basis both the lake water & surrounding watershed. At this time we are delighted to report that our lake is in excellent condition — considered by many to be the best in Southern Michigan.


SAILING NEWS

NEW PWC LAWS IN EFFECT FOR '99 BOATING SEASON. From our Boating Safety Committee: As the boating season begins, there are a number of new and revised laws concerning PWCs that we need to be aware of so that everyone will be able to enjoy a safe, fun-filled season.

- 1. No one shall operate a PWC unless each person 12 years of age or older, riding on or being towed behind a PWC is wearing a type I, II or III, Coast Guard approved, personal flotation device. (Always look for that label when you buy.) Anyone born after Dec.31, 1978 must have a boating safety certificate.
- 2. No one shall operate a PWC unless each person on board or being towed by the PWC who is less than 12 years of age is wearing a Type I or II personal flotation device.
- 3. No one shall operate a PWC if a child who is under 7 years of age is on board or being towed behind the PWC, unless the child is in the company of his or her parent or guardian or a designee of the parent or guarlian.
- 4. While operating a PWC equipped by the manufacturer with a lanyard-type cutoff switch, the lanyard must be attached to his or her person, clothing, or personal flotation device as is appropriate for the PWC.
- 5. No one may operate a PWC during the period that begins one hour before sunset and ends at 8 am. "Sunset" means that time determined by the National Weather Service.

- 6. A PWC operator shall not cross within 150 feet behind another vessel, other than a PWC, unless the person is operating at slow--nowake speed.
- 7. A person shall operate a PWC in a reasonable and prudent manner. A maneuver that unreasonably or unnecessarily endangers life, limb, or property, including but not limited to all of the following, constitutes reckless operation:

Weaving through congested traffic. Jumping the wake of another vessel unreasonably OR unnecessarily close to the other vessel, or when visibility around the other vessel is obstructed.

- 8. Beginning with March 31, 2000, nonresidents of Michigan will be required to obtain a boating safety certificate in order to operate a PWC in this state.
- 9. The owner of a PWC or the person having charge over or control of a PWC (renter and or a rentee?) shall not authorize or permit the personal water craft to be operated in violation of these laws.

Please be aware of what is happening all around you and remember to be considerate of the others who also enjoy using our lake. Also all boaters need to remember that you are required to have your licenses with you, even on PWCs. It is suggested that you photocopy and laminate them and keep the real thing at home. Thanks. Your Boating Safety Committee


