EDITORS EDIBLES

"Onions To Kill For"

With the arrival of Corey Lake onions at the market, I would like to share one of my favorite recipes.

SLOW COOKED ONIONS WITH TARRAGON MUSTARD SAUCE

For the onions:

4 med size Corey Lake onions

3T olive oil

1/2tsp salt

1/4tsp freshly ground pepper

For the Tarragon mustard sauce:

2T white or tarragon vinegar

2T Dijon -style mustard

1/3C olive oil

2T chopped fresh tarragon

1/4tsp salt

Pinch of freshly ground pepper

To prepare the onions, peel them carefully; take care to keep their layers intact at the root ends, which help hold them together during cooking. Using a sharp knife, slice an X in each onion within 1 inch of the root end. In a large bowl, toss the onions with the olive oil and salt and pepper.

Place the onions on the center of the rack; cover the grill and open the vents halfway. Cook turning the onions every 15 to 20 min. (For 45 to 50 min. until tender)

Meanwhile, whisk together the vinegar, mustard, salt and pepper. Slowly add the olive oil, whisking constantly. When creamy whisk in the fresh tarragon.

To serve, transfer the onions to a platter and drizzle sauce over them. Serve hot or at room temperature. Great with steaks, chicken or just about anything.

Star Stuff

The dark sky over Birch Lake is great for viewing stars and planets. Last week, while sitting out on the pier, I noticed several bright streaks in the sky... meteors. One of the highlights of summer sky watching is the Perseid

meteor shower... a "sprinkle" of shooting stars. Like all meteor showers, the Perseids occur when Earth flies through the orbital path of a comet. Comets are messy objects. As they orbit the Sun, they shed tiny bits of rock and dirt — most no bigger than a grain of sand. As Earth moves through the comet's orbital path, some of this comet dust slams into our atmosphere at thousands of miles an hour. Friction with the atmosphere generates intense heat, so the dust grains vaporize, creating bright streaks of light or shooting stars.

With the New Moon on Aug. 11, this year will be particularly good for the Perseids. It's at its best on the nights of Wed. and Thurs., Aug. 11-12 and 12-13. The greatest number of meteors will likely be seen after midnight and into the predawn darkness hours of Thursday and Friday, Aug. 12 and 13.

Find a comfortable lawn chair, sit back and enjoy.

Keep looking up.



Fish Tails:

Watch the deep early mornings & you may see feeding activity on the surface of the lake. Look for a 3 foot silver flash to see the GAR fish at their breakfast.

Gar (spear) is the name given to fishes with long narrow bodies & bony sharp-toothed beaks. These primitive fish live primarily in fresh water ranging from southern Quebec to Cuba. The largest, the tropical Gar, grow to 12 feet! AHH.

The teeth are needlelike, the dorsal fin is far back on it's heavily scaled body & the vertebrae are ball-&-socket structure found in some reptiles. The fish spawn each spring in large groups. The roe is toxic to many animals including man.

This large predator is a rough fish that can be caught with bait or flies (though dynamite might work better). In years past Lakers would mount lights on their pontoon boats to attract Gar & slowly circle the lake with long handled spears. 3-5 foot Gar were displayed in morning.


