etc... Contact John and Nyla Erhardt at 476.9944.


Spratts to visit



Pet of the week






Birds of a feather flock together at Birch Lake ...

Justin would do the same thing right along with me. He probably thought I was crazy and, I was and

still am. Regardless of how crazy I am Justin was always around for me when I needed a friend and, he still is around when I need him. His entire family has been wonderful to me and I thank them for everything. You all help make this place home and, I hope remembering Justin's giant smile brings one to all of your faces. I love you all.

I have many crazy memories about Sheriff Dan and his boys. Dan was the first person I ever had ridden a motorcycle with. Dan also is the man who issued my boating license; I imagine he still regrets doing that. Dan to this day has the wondrous ability to scare me to death. One afternoon in July two years ago Dan sent his cronies out looking for me. His men didn't need to look far because; I was docking the boat next door. As I was docking two men walked out onto my families' pier. The two men grabbed the boat and, asked me how much I had been drinking. I replied and said "None that I know of." Apparently these two gentlemen still had to arrest me. I was then handcuffed and walked off of our pier. Dan walked down and proceeded to tell me that, I was driving too fast. (Gee what a shock). Dan and Shervi have been great friends and neighbors and, I will miss all of our road trips and, hair cuts as I head off to school.



When I was younger and I would fall or hurt myself Grandpa told me to get into the healing waters of Birch Lake so I would feel better. Now when I come to the lake, these waters put me at peace and I enjoy life with family and friends. I am saying goodbye for now but, I hope to be at Birch Lake for summers and years to come. I feel incredibly blessed to call this place home and, you should too!



lue moon, I saw you standing alone...

e have watched the moon over the lake as it passes through its cycle from full to new and back to full again. That cycle takes about 29 and a half days to complete. That means that once in a while the cycle can begin again within a single calendar month. When that happens, the second full moon is called a Blue Moon. But is it ever really blue?

In September of 1950 it was. From British Columbia to the British Isles, the

Moon looked a bit odd. Instead of its usual silvery countenance, it did look distinctly blue.

This odd appearance was the result of forest fires in western Canada. Tiny particles of ash rose high into the atmosphere, where they were carried eastward. These particles were just the right size and composition to scatter some of the red wavelengths of moonlight. The blue passed through unfiltered.

Such "true-blue" moons are unusual but not unheard of. One of the most widespread occurred after the explosion of Krakatoa in 1883. The plume of volcanic ash spread around much of the

globe.

Yet "blue moons" are so rare that they became important to the English language. At first, if someone said that something was as likely to happen as a blue moon, they meant it would never happen at all. Over time, though, the meaning changed, so the phrase "once in a blue moon" came to mean "once in a great while."

In the last couple of decades, "blue moon" has gained a

new meaning. It's the name given to a second full Moon in any calendar month -something that happens on average about once every two and a half years. Our last full moon was on July 2nd. Tonight marks the second full moon of July. With the moon as bright as it is much of the show will be greatly diminished. But go out and enjoy what's there anyway. And it's still free.


Ø Sisterhood of the Traveling Pants (Brashares)




