




#### **Newberg EMS Ambulance Department Port-A-Pit BBQ**



## Safe boating reminders:

Capacity plates are located in the vessel for your safety. Remember each person weighs 150 pounds according to the law (but not your tailor). Do not exceed this number or pound value. Failure to do so may be viewed as "careless operation".

Other Important Reminders:

- PFDs cannot be stored in plastic bags.
- All boats must stay at least 200 feet away from a diving flag. A diving flag is a red flag with a diagonal white stripe. It may be seen on a floating buoy or even displayed on a boat.
- The operator of the vessel must have the registration on board.
- Intoxicated vessel opera-

tors go to jail!

- You are liable for damage caused by your wake.
- It is illegal to ride on the side (gunwale) or covered bow of the boat, unless the manufacturer designed the boat for that use.
- Children 12 to 16 years of age must have a Boating Safety Certificate to operate a motorboat of six horsepower or more. The certificate must be in their possession while operating the boat.
- Some insurance companies give lower rates to skippers who have completed safety courses.
- When towing a skier or tuber it is essential to let your observer observe while you pilot the boat.







# Stu's Star Stuff



# Defining the constellations


stretch across the southern sky at nightfall. Leo nosedives toward the western horizon: Virgo stretches to its southeast; Scorpius is due south, and Sagittarius is climbing in the southeast, close to the full Moon.

These famous constellations consist of more than stick figures outlined by bright stars, though. They have precise boundaries, like the borders between countries or states here on Earth. Those boundaries received final approval from astronomers 75 years ago.

Until then, there was no universally accepted system for defining the constellations. Different star atlases showed different borders, and even entirely different constellations. But this chaos made it tough for astronomers to compare notes on their discoveries.

So in 1925, the International Astronomical Union appointed Eugene Delporte, an astronomer and draftsman, to create a uniform map of the sky — divided into 88 constellations.

Using several existing atlases as guides, Delporte drew boundaries along



lines that are equivalent to the lines of latitude and longitude on Earth. But he created some odd shapes to make sure that the constellations incorporated all the correct stars from the classical star patterns.

The IAU approved Delporte's work in 1928. But it wasn't finalized until it was published in 1930. This work laid out the geography of the sky, and gave every star its own constellation to call home.

On a different note, for you meteor enthusiasts, the Delta Aquarid meteor shower reached its peak on Thursday night. It is not a strong shower, producing a meteor every 4 or 5 minutes on average. But its peak is broad, lasting a week or


more, so there are still some meteors to be seen. Also, the Delta Aquarid shower overlaps with the beginning of the well-known Perseid shower. So some observers think of the Delta Aquarids as the warmup act for the Perseids.


More on that later. Get comfortable in a lawn chair and see how many you can spot. The later you're out there the better. This show goes on at no charge.


